At intersection of U.S. 21 and U.S. 17 Alt. Just 6 miles down the road from the Old Sheldon Church ruins, Harold's Country Club is where *Road House* meets *The Andy Griffith Show*. Here, you can gas up your ride, buy bait and tackle, pop open a cold PBR, and get in on a game of pool. Each Saturday night, this filling station/dive bar serves up chargrilled 14-ounce rib eyes to everyone from blue collar heroes to rice plantation owners.

WHY WE LOVE IT: You reserve your food, not a table. On Saturday nights at Harold's, reservations are for the main event: the meat. Call ahead and place your order (how many and how you want them cooked), and when your party shows up at 6:30 or 8 p.m., your steaks will be ready for you. 843/589-4360 →
